◆ **Hybrid Cars**

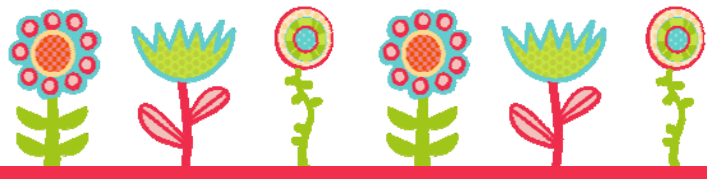
McCarthy Chevrolet will have a Chevrolet Tahoe Hybrid on display. A representative will be available to answer questions on the benefits of hybrid vehicles.
